1.	Apologies	Martin Avery (MA). PG apologised for missing the RA meeting in September.	
2.	Minutes of the last meeting	The committee agreed minutes of meeting held on 5th September 2017.	
3.	Matters arising	Parish Council has reimbursed the expenses for Cambridge Conservation Initiative. After the RA committee received the letter from 1 st Bar Hill Scouts requesting a donation, Roger Hall and Lorna Adams has resigned from the 1 st Bar Hill Scouts committee. Marina Dellar is currently the Scout leader. Since their current situation is not very clear, the RA committee has decided to put their request for donation on hold. Following a request for donation from the Bar Hill church, the RA committee agreed to donate £330 towards the cost of tables/table trolley. BW proposed this donation and HW seconded it.

5.	Correspondence	RA committee received a request for donation from Pam Vandy on behalf of Bar Hill Neighbourhood Watch. NW is planning to circulate a leaflet in December highlighting the need for better awareness regarding cybercrime. The cost of the leaflet printing will be around £300 +VAT. MN proposed for RA to meet the full cost of this leaflet printing and BW seconded the proposal. The committee agreed. AP and RH disclosed that they were part of Bar Hill NW to the RA committee.

7.	Donation to Bar Hill School	RA committee deferred the decision regarding contribution towards the play equipment for reception children. Currently, the school is carrying out building work in the proposed area. In addition, the RA committee is aware about the funds raised in memory of Dawn Miller and the funds from South Cambridgeshire council that is available for the same purpose.
